

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

OCTOBER 2024

- The RIC committee submitted a new welcoming statement that was approved by Council.
- The gift card program is up & running. The God's Work, Our Hands committee will be offering gift cards for families Thanksgiving needs. Community members will have the opportunity to contribute to the cost of the cards by special envelopes or noting the purpose of the check in the memo line. Please see Michel Lloyd with questions.
- There will be a Congregation Meeting on Sunday, December 1. At this meeting we will be voting on the first official budget of Blessed Trinity at Rosemont and electing Council members. To mark this monumental achievement, we will be celebrating with a catered luncheon in Laros Hall following the meeting.
- A new envelope design for 2025 was approved.
- Approved a \$500 donation to the live Bethlehem Christmas pageant.
- Elevator/atrium update: Council held a special meeting on Thursday, October 17. Tom Maloney, our architect, presented the basic structural proposal for the elevator and atrium space and proposed the next step of putting the plans out for bid. Council unanimously voted to accept the plans and approved beginning the bidding process. The plans will be submitted to three contractors on Monday, October 21 or Tuesday, October 22, with a deadline of the end of November for submitting bids. The congregation will have an opportunity to view poster-size renderings of the project by the beginning of December.
